

TERMS AND CONDITIONS LEI REQUEST

*The LEI Request Service is provided by **Work Allround** (LEI: 7245007CS2LXYD2JCT52). Work Allround is an official LEI Registration Agent and operates under the trademark **MultipLEI** globally.*

1. About the Terms

- a. These Terms apply to and form part of the contract between MultipLEI and its clients (the Client). They supersede any previously issued terms and conditions.
- b. No variation of these Terms shall be binding unless expressly agreed in writing by a duly authorised signatory on behalf of MultipLEI. MultipLEI may vary these terms if such variation is required by the Global Legal Entity Identifier Foundation (GLEIF) or to comply with any agreement to which MultipLEI is a party to with a Local Operating Unit (LOU).
- c. These Terms should be read carefully before using MultipLEI's services.
- d. MultipLEI operates as an Official Registration Agent of the Global Legal Entity Identifier Foundation (GLEIF).
- e. MultipLEI operates as an Official Registration Agent for the GLEIF in the name of the Client and cooperates with GLEIF accredited LOUs to order or renew Legal Entity Identifiers (LEIs) for its clients.
- f. MultipLEI is not legally affiliated with any LOU and may use different LOUs depending on the prevailing conditions within the market. MultipLEI does not operate as a LOU in respect of LEIs.

2. LEI Request

- a. To purchase, renew or transfer an LEI, the Client must fill in the LEI Request Form on the MultipLEI website.
- b. By submitting the form, the Client accepts these terms and conditions. The applicant confirms they have full authority to apply for an LEI on behalf of the Client.
- c. The Client gives all rights to MultipLEI to apply for, renew or transfer an LEI on the Client's behalf. MultipLEI is authorised to sign the LOU's Terms of Services (e.g. RapidLEI Terms of Service) on behalf of the Client.
- d. MultipLEI will provide the new LEI or proof of renewal/transfer as soon as the payment has been received.

3. Client's Obligations and Liability

- a. On receipt of the LEI details, the Client must check the validity using the global GLEIF webpage.
- b. The Client is obligated to supply true, full and authentic information and promptly submit any changes.

c. The Client will indemnify MultipLEI against all damages, liabilities and claims arising from any breach of contract by the Client.

4. Fees

- a. Fees are published on the MultipLEI pricing page. All fees are exclusive of VAT.
- b. MultipLEI may increase its fees at any time.
- c. Once an LEI has been issued, the Client will not be refunded for any fees paid.

5. Responsibility

The Client uses the service of MultipLEI entirely at their own risk. Under no circumstances will MultipLEI be liable for loss of data, revenue, business or any indirect or consequential damages.

6. Relationship and Disputes

- a. The relationship between MultipLEI and the Client is regulated by Dutch law. The Client and MultipLEI are independent persons and are not partners, principal and agent or employer and employee.
- b. MultipLEI will try to resolve any disputes with its Clients quickly and efficiently.
- c. If the Client is unhappy with MultipLEI please contact MultipLEI as soon as possible.

7. Waiver

The waiver by either Party of a breach, default, delay or omission of any of the provisions of this Agreement by the other Party will not be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or other provisions.

8. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

- a. The contract and any dispute or claim arising out of, or in connection with, it shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the Netherlands.
- b. The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of the Netherlands shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim arising out of, or in connection with, the contract.
